Re: Documentation Errors within CANImmunize Clinic Flow

Nova Scotia Health has advised the NSCP that there are documentation errors in CANImmunize Clinic Flow. In particular, the Pfizer Adult vaccine is being chosen for pediatric clinics. For clarity, while the individual is receiving the correct vaccine, the patient record in CANImmunize is incorrect.

Nova Scotia Health has notified and continues to notify pharmacies when this occurs, and it is critical that pharmacy managers take the necessary steps to ensure that these records are corrected as soon as possible.

It is crucial that processes are put in place to prevent these types of documentation errors. Pharmacy practitioners are encouraged to review [guidance provided by Nova Scotia Health](#) to avoid documentation errors.
